Planning the Garden

Specifications

- 🌸 Site - to the north of the Brooklin Horticultural Garden Park sign, 131 Carnwith Drive, W.
- 🌸 Size - 20' X 10" at widest part
- 🌸 Shape - rectangular or curved
- 🌸 Plant Materials - must reflect what would have appeared in a typical member's garden in 1920's -1940's
- 🌸 Include - perennials, annuals, bulbs, shrubs & perhaps small trees

Considerations

- 🌸 Colour, form, bloom progression - early spring through fall
- 🌸 Research plant collections from that time period; Cottage Gardener, R.B.Gardens, Laking Garden list, long time BHS members
- 🌸 We will be purchasing a large number of narcissus "Rip Van Winkle"; 6" mop-head, bright yellow, bloom early
- 🌸 It can get very dry & windy in the site recommended & there's not much shade
- 🌸 Visit the Brooklin Hort Garden Park to see what you're dealing with -make a case for a different location
